**10/136 APOLOGIES**

Apologies were received from Councillor Bob Simpson.

**10/137 MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 19 OCTOBER 2010**

Minutes previously circulated. Agreed and signed as a correct record.

**10/138 CLERK'S REPORT AND MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

- a. Clerk had reported the remaining blocked drain in South Back Lane to NYCC Highways.
- b. The BMX track had been removed and the site secured by Railtrack.
- c. Councillor Spark had met with Kevin Nicholson of NYCC Highways at the railway bridge and Mr Nicholson had seen first hand the problems of speeding over the bridge. And that on Newton Road. He would see what could be done and would contact the Traffic Police Sergeant. Pot holes were also noted but most in the centre had already been patched up. Clerk to follow up with email to NYCC Highways.
- d. The landowner responsible for the fly tipping removal had not been identified.
- e. Councillor Sowray reported that the Environment Agency did not believe that there had been a pollution spillage at the landfill site due to the clear test results provided by the landfill contractor. They had however promised to visit the site tomorrow and Councillor Sowray would follow this up. NYCC confirmed that the height of the capped site had been reduced but the legal department were considering whether a planning infringement notice would be issued. Clerk to also contact Environment Agency.
- f. Only one allotment rent was now outstanding.
- g. Councillor Brown had not been able to carry out the pothole survey due to illness.
- h. The Clerk had circulated a map of the conservation area to all Councillors.
- i. An unknown person had cleared and tidied the drinking trough.
- j. Hambleton DC confirmed the temporary home at the Windmill did not require planning permission until after the works were completed.
- k. The ROSPA report had been received from Playsafety Ltd. This would be looked at by Councillor Wadsworth. She would also issue monthly reports which the Clerk would forward to the Sports & Recreation Club.

The contract for Allerton Park incinerator plant would be decided soon.
