

Think of a piece of classical music. In the same way that the rhythms of a piece of music allow for elaborate and simple melodies to co-exist, so our faith flourishes and grows more melodic as we pattern ourselves around spiritual rhythms. These can include -reading and praying the Bible, -worshipping in church, -loving one another in our communities, -living generously, -telling others how God's transforming love helps us in our everyday lives and -resting well. Do you identify with any of these?

I wonder what rhythms you adopt to enrich your life? Regular exercise, being out in nature, resting, investing in friendships, communicating well, learning new things, caring for those who are in need or meditating?

I would argue that these everyday ways of living well are also important to grow spiritually as well as physically. They are closer to Christian disciplines than you might first imagine!

Prayer has meditative aspects, as we empty our minds of stuff, to focus on God.

Learning is a key part of faith; having a living faith means that we always find new situations when we can love or forgive and live like Jesus.

Caring for those in need is about loving our neighbour and putting others first.

Communicating well with one another is only a small step away from communing with God: call it prayer or worship.

Being in nature recognises the beauty and wonder of things created.

During the summer months, I pray we will all have opportunity to pause, give thanks and reset physically, emotionally and spiritually.

The Pearson and Others Charitable Trust


