# *Alne Singers*

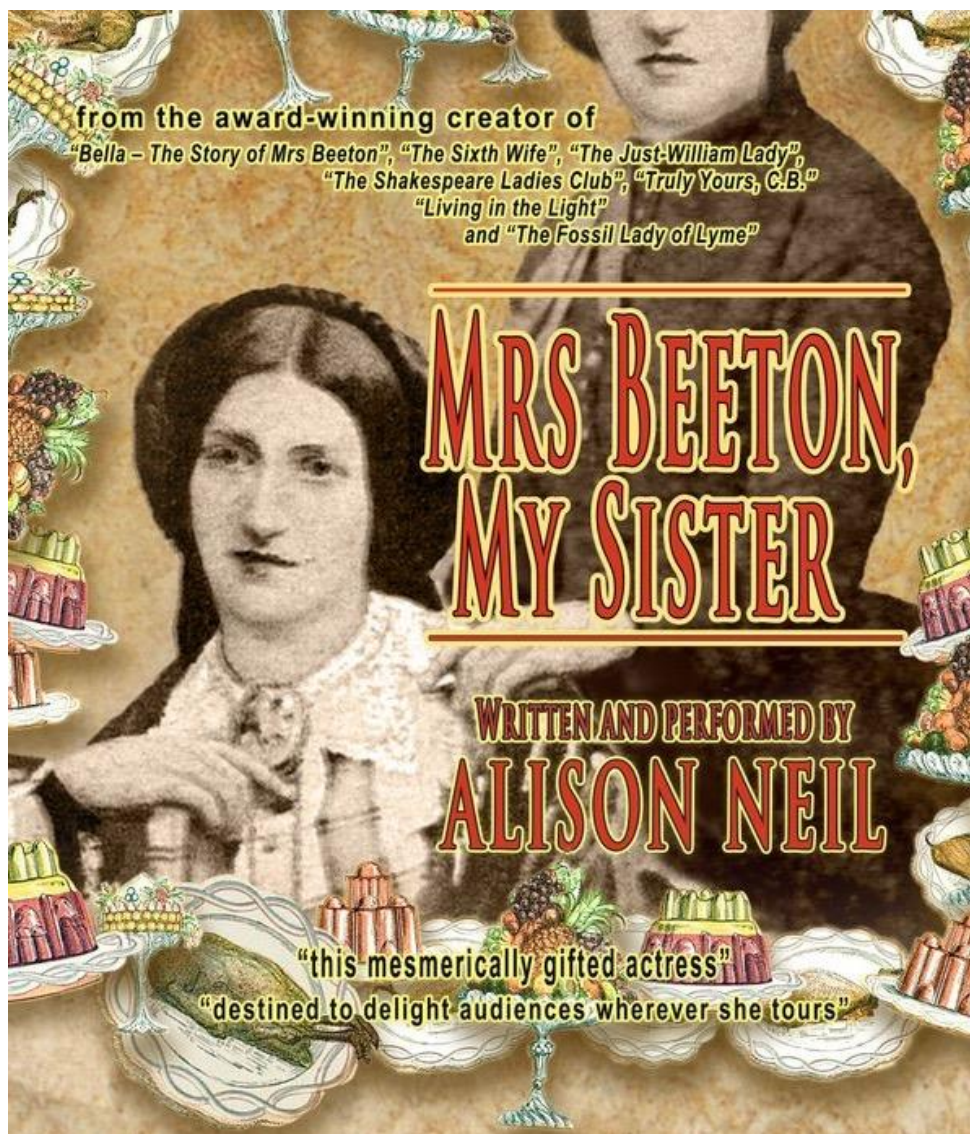
*Come and give it a try!*
