Whether you are thinking of joining us at church or not, we hope you will find plenty of useful information here to help you to settle into your new home.

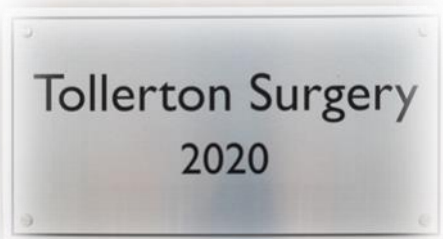
Sunday services are at **10.30am** nearly every week- just check our **Facebook** page in case there is a change.

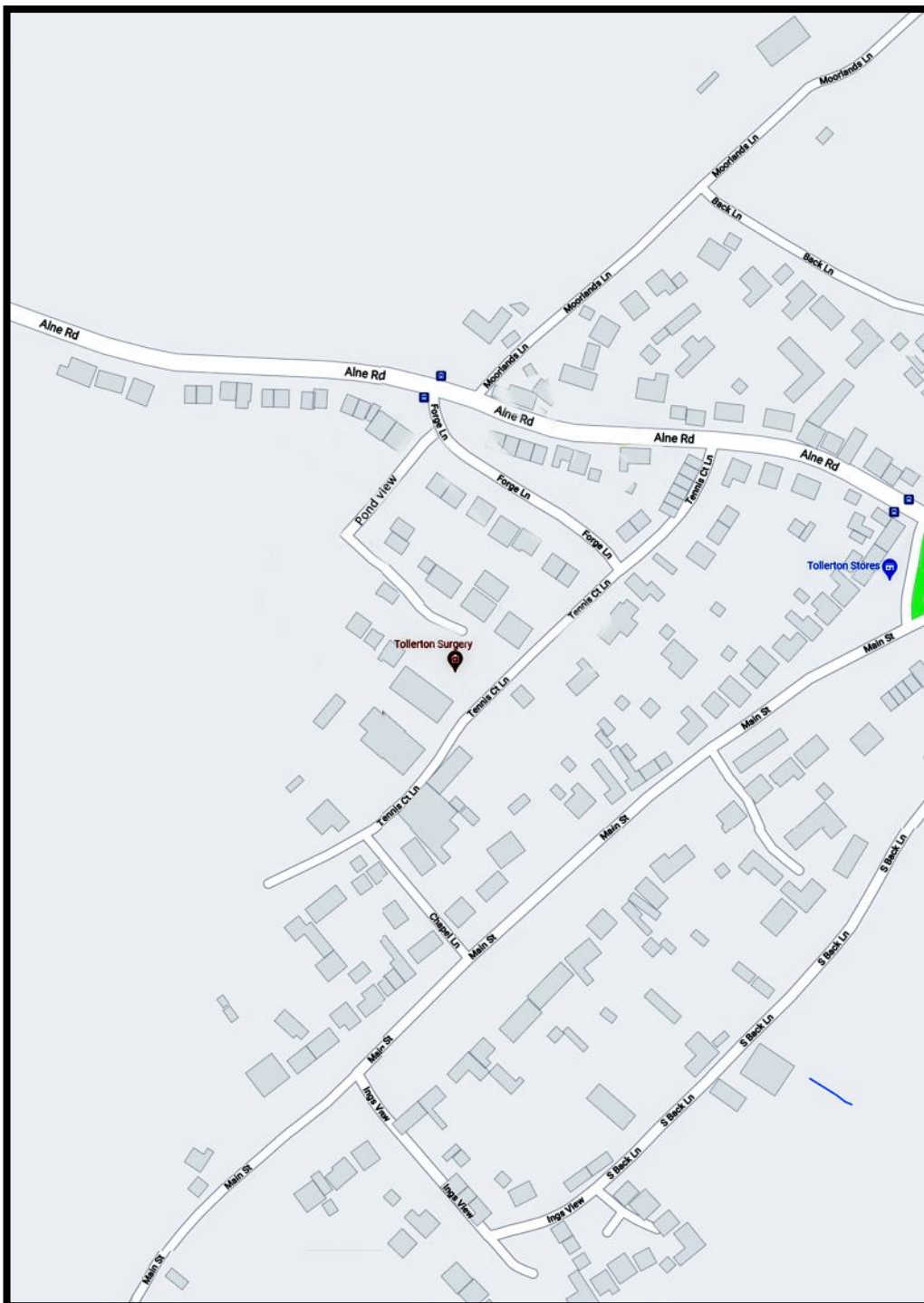


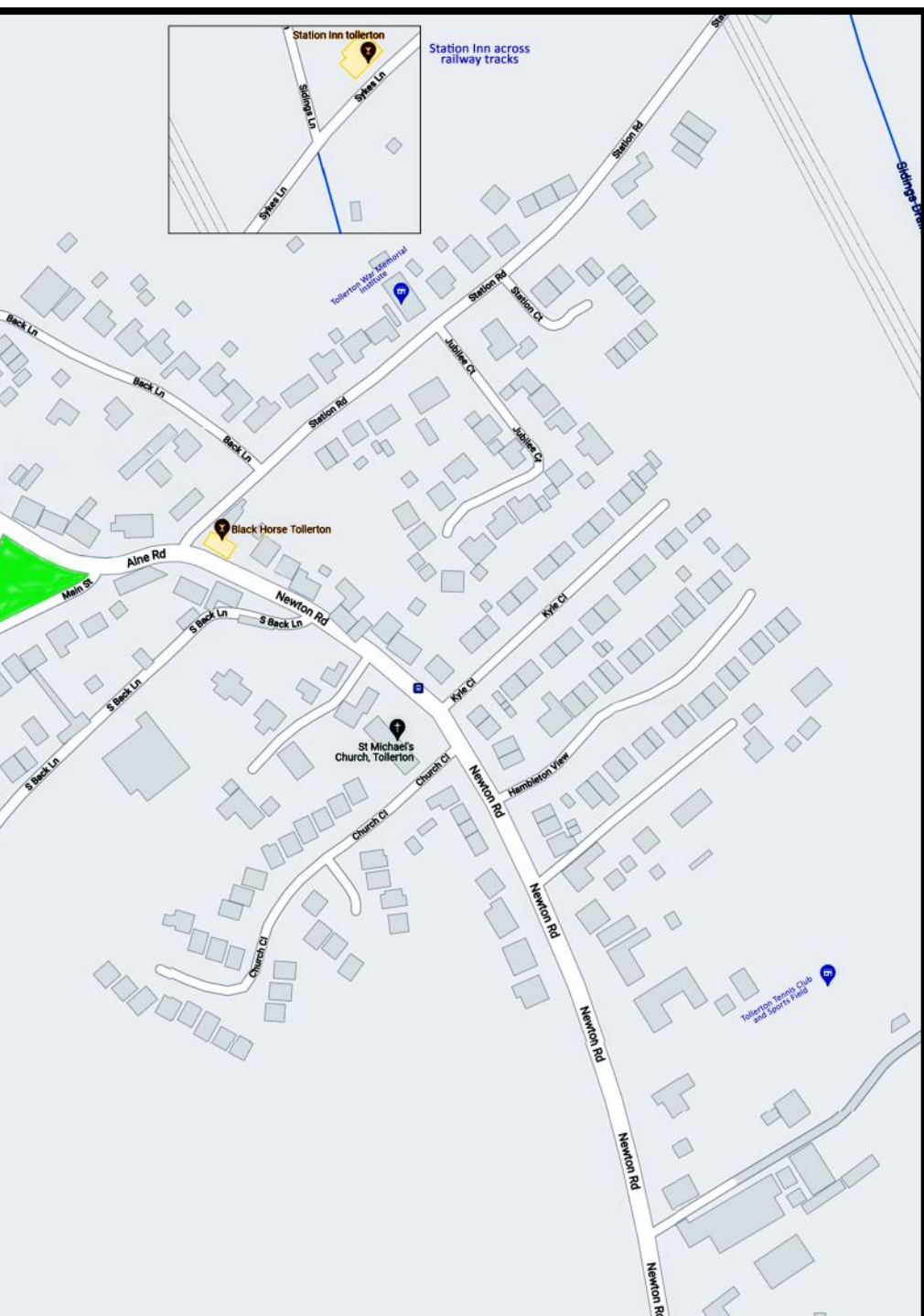
