1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

Councillor Jacqui McAlpine was unanimously elected as Chairman.

4. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 5 MAY 2009

Minutes previously circulated. Agreed and signed as a correct record.

5. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- 5.1 The Youth Van team had put up posters. No Councillors had seen the van in the village but would report back next month if they saw it.
- 5.2 A quotation had been received from a local firm for a replacement notice board. It was decided to wait another month to see if any additional quotations were received.
- 5.3 The village green seat work was to be carried out by Mark Brown on Saturday. The Chairman would find out what time and email everyone so anyone available could go to help.
- 5.4 A letter had been received from the surgery about the parking. It detailed the efforts they had made to encourage patients to use the Church car park. The Clerk to write to NYCC Highways to see if yellow lines could be put around the entrance to Hambleton View to make the junction less dangerous. Also to write to Mr Taylor letting him know what the Council had done.
- 5.5 The contractor had treated the village green against dandelions.
- 5.6 No reply had been received regarding the static caravans at the caravan park.
- 5.7 No reply had been received from NYCC Highways regarding the pot holes in Tennis Court Lane.
- 5.8 Council is awaiting permission to publish the winners of the Parish Plan Competition on the website.
- 5.9 The Clerk had contacted the Environment Agency regarding the discharges into Sidings Lane and was awaiting a visit by an officer to the site.
