**10/150 APOLOGIES**

Apologies were received from Councillor Gill Wadsworth and County Councillor Peter Sowray.

**10/151 MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 9 NOVEMBER 2010**

Minutes previously circulated. Agreed and signed as a correct record.

**10/152 CLERK'S REPORT AND MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

- a. Given the snowy weather it was impossible to see whether there was still a problem with flooding at South Back Lane at this time.
- b. Nothing further had been received from Network Rail or NYCC regarding the railway bridge meeting.
- c. After communication with Councillor Gaudian of Alne Parish Council it was agreed Councillor Jackson would write to Alne Parish Council offering support to their concerns regarding the pollution from the landfill site and offer to write any letters necessary. A visit to Alne Parish Council's next meeting was not felt appropriate.
- d. The pot hole survey would be undertaken after the weather had improved.

**10/153 PUBLIC FORUM**

The situation as regards the pollution from the landfill site was discussed.

It was agreed to move the salt bin on the green as this had resulted in spilt salt killing the grass and threatened the bulbs planted below. It would be located outside Hill Cottage near the lamp post.

**10/154 PLANNING APPLICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION**

- a. 10/02687/FUL - Proposed extension and alterations to existing dwelling at The Courtyard, Fleetbank Barns, Tollerton for Mr & Mrs Ian Guildford. Wish to see **APPROVED**.

10/02682/FUL - Construction of 6 no. poultry units for broiler rearing at Street Record, Fleet Bank Lane, Tollerton for Mr Phil Mason. Wish to see **REFUSED**. This is because there will be problems with the main road and back road junctions. It will be of no economic benefit to the village. Environmentally the smell will be a problem to nearby residents and the prevailing wind will take the smell to the recreational fish ponds which bring benefit to the village. The increased traffic movements of the heavy vehicles will make an additional noise nuisance.
