## Speeding Concern - Tollerton, Station Road

Further to our recent correspondence with yourself, I am writing to provide you with an update from our meeting of the Hambleton & Richmondshire Speed Matrix Group held on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2013

At this meeting it was noted that the data logger has now been deployed for a 7 day period commencing 10<sup>th</sup> December 2012 at a location on Station Road opposite the Village Hall as identified with Cllr Mark Brown and James Titchener, with the following results:

- Towards Tollerton 85% of the vehicles were travelling at a speed of 33mph or less over the period of deployment, with approximately 5,587 vehicles;
- Away from Tollerton 85% of the vehicles were travelling at a speed of 29mph or less over the period of deployment, with approximately 7,704 vehicles.

From this process and analysis of the data it has shown that the speeds recorded are commensurate with the expected results within a 30mph speed limit and we have concluded that no further action is required at this present time. We appreciate it is often found that perceived speed is significantly higher than the actual recorded speed and in this instance this is what the data and analysis have identified.
