15/65 PUBLIC FORUM

A member of the public asked what is happening with the website. After discussion it was resolved to use the Tollerton website and include the Parish Council information on that website.

The drain outside the pub is blocked again causing flooding down Station Road it was agreed to put pressure on the County Council to do a gully inspection as there are also one or two drains around the village blocked some down. Clerk to organise a gully inspection.

The Bridge at Sykes Lane/Station Road - bushes have grown right through the fencing on to the path causing pedestrians to be on the road. It was agreed the bushes need trimming back. The Clerk will contact G. Marston Garden & fencing services asking for an estimate to trim the bushes and also a one off trim of the grass up the Back Lane, the corner of various roads where the grass is growing and right down south of Back Lane.

The bridge at Sykes Lane is a real hazard can the Parish Council ask NYCC for a pavement. It was agreed to speak to the Highways Engineer and make an enquiry.. There were continuing concerns about the volume of traffic passing through the village.
