Public Forum

Tim Brook advised he is looking into obtaining a grant for the village hall roof but the application requires confirmation from a third party as a donor to the scheme and asked if the Parish Council can be nominated, the maximum amount that would be payable is £2875.67. It was agreed the Parish Council can be nominated.

4.1 Defibrillator cabinet – This has been ordered and delivery is awaited.

4.2 Replacement Trees at Old Way – Cllr Jackson advised the trees have been removed. There is not a huge amount of space for any further trees. If we plant further trees they may get into wires, worth having another look maybe space for one tree. Cllrs Spark and Cllr Jackson will look and assess the situation.

4.3 Dropped Kerb on the Green – the Clerk confirmed the application has been lodged with NYCC.

4.4 Request for Zebra crossing – There was no further news from NYCC the clerk will chase NYCC.

4.5 Jubilee Celebrations – Cllr Brookes advised the celebrations will be over 4 days with the main event taking place on the Sunday everyone sits down to have something to eat a questionnaire is going out.

4.6 Church Embankment – It was felt that the Church needed to pay 50% of the quote from Gary Marston less the VAT. This has been put to the Church Committee, but a decision is awaited.

21/02259/FUL alterations to the existing outbuilding to form a 1 bed annex with new staircase to store above and construction of a garden shed Oakwood House, Main Street, Tollerton there were no objections **Council wished to see approved.**

21/02196/FUL construction of 4 no bungalows and formation of new vehicular and pedestrian access and formation of dropped kerb to maintain farm access OS Feld 3000 land to the West of Newton Road, Tollerton. It was agreed to wait until the outcome of the survey and the meeting in the Village Hall on the 14th. Cllr Thompson will ask the planning department for an extension of time.
