### Somewhere over the Rainbow – from despair to elation!

'Somewhere over the rainbow, skies are blue and the dreams that you dare to dream really do come true'.

I am sure many of you will be familiar with these words sung by Dorothy in the song from the Wizard of Oz....a song of hope....dreaming of a better world. However, hope is an increasingly scarce commodity today. In our day to day world we are sucked into being more cynical, we are drawn into a dog eat dog battle to survive where looking after number one or our immediate families and friends becomes our priority. 'Life's a ??????? and then you die!' as one of my colleagues in the sweet factory where I worked before ordination used to say.

The Easter story again is a story of hope – but hope which comes from despair.

On the Friday we see despair - Jesus betrayed by one friend and deserted by the others – tried by a kangaroo court in front of a judge too weak and interested in his own reputation to stand for justice.....On the Saturday there is an emptiness – an overwhelming sense of loss and grief for what might have been......Then on the Sunday elation – Jesus the crucified one has risen – he has overcome the ultimate enemy of our earthly life – death itself.

#### Alne Oil Co-operative

Founder member of the Lower Swale Syndicate of Oil Co-operatives

In the past year, Tate Fuels of Otley have supplied the members of The Lower Swale Syndicate of Oil Co-operatives with 1.15 million litres of heating oil.

The arrangement is clearly working, so we have agreed a three-year agreement for Tate Fuels to continue as our supplier.

There are improvements to the current arrangements inasmuch as:

- **Improved delivery time:** the order will be delivered within ten working days (emergency next working day deliveries can be made at an additional cost).
- Shorter Christmas cut-off: Order any time between 1 January and 30 November — this is to encourage Members to assist Tate Fuels by ordering outside their peak time. Orders placed during December for delivery before the end of the month, will be charged at the prevailing commercial price and delivered according to availability.
- **New service:** Members requiring notification of delivery date can ask to be sent a text message the previous day, so that gates and tanks can be left unlocked.

A minimum delivery of 500 litres is mandated by Weights and Measures legislation. Payment will continue to be made by single Direct Debit payment following delivery.
