Loss of lead from roof

On Wednesday 12 December more than 150 people gathered at Alne Church for the funeral of the late Fred Gill. Two nights later thieves climbed on to the roof and took some of the lead, mainly from the roof gully on the south side of the nave. This sickening action, which damaged a significant and well-loved building, will be expensive to repair (even with some insurance cover). As it happens, the architect had advised earlier in the year that the lead would have to be replaced and The Rev Chris Park and the PCC will be launching an appeal soon.
